





PRE-EVENT TESTING (PET)

Pre-Event Testing (PET) status check
For [Events that require PET](#), F&B outlets, gyms and other venues where differentiated SMMs may be implemented.

SAFE DISTANCING MEASURES

Restrict visitors on odd/even dates
Visitors will be restricted according to the last digit of their NRIC (e.g SXXXXXX1B). Visitors with NRICs ending in odd digits may only enter on odd dates and visitors with even last digits may only enter on even dates.

By enabling the PET Status Check, you **HEREBY UNDERSTAND AND AGREE** that:

- (1) If you are enabling the PET Status Check on behalf of a business, company or other entity ("**Organisation**"), you represent and warrant that you have been validly authorised to do so and to bind the Organisation to these terms and conditions. In such circumstances, any reference to "**you**" or "**your**" in these terms and conditions shall include your Organisation;
- (2) you will and will ensure that any persons that are employed or engaged by you to carry out the PET Status Check:
 - (a) will carry out the PET Status Check only for the purpose of verifying, in the course of performing a SafeEntry check-in, if the individual checking-in is required to undergo PET;
 - (b) will only use the PET Status Check to

- (4) you must comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations, including but not limited to the Personal Data Protection Act 2012 ("**PDPA**"). By enabling the PET Status Check to verify if individuals are required to undergo PET, you may be given access to the personal data of those individuals. **Under the PDPA, unauthorised disclosure or improper use of personal data by you or your employees is an offence and may render you liable to a fine or imprisonment or both.**

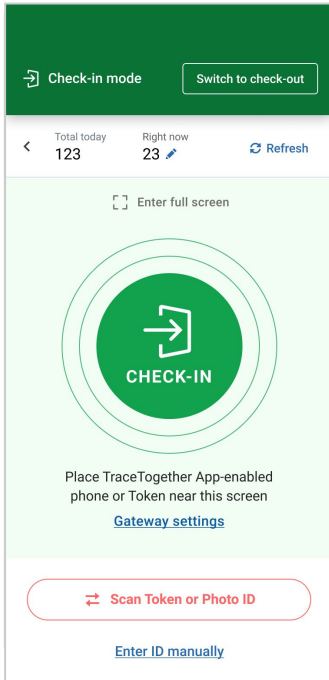

PET Status Check statuses

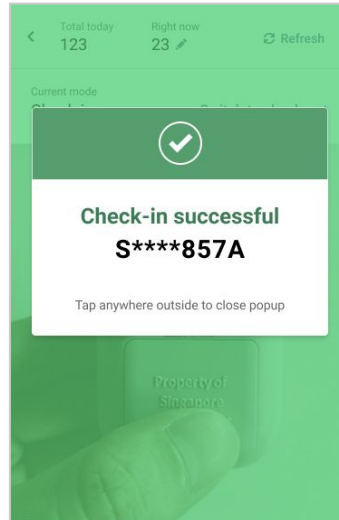
Using SafeEntry (Business) App



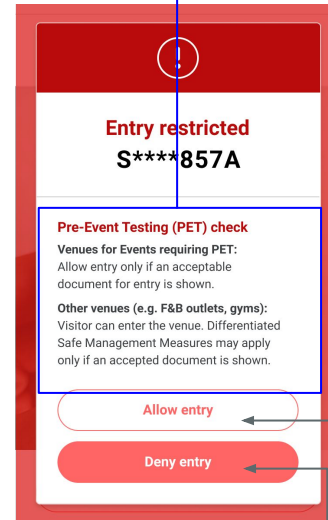
SafeEntry Gateway



From Scan Token/ID screen



A confirmation in green with last 3-digits of ID is shown if the visitor can be exempted from PET



An alert is shown if visitor does not clear PET status check.

- Venues for Events requiring PET: Allow entry only if an acceptable document for entry is shown.
- Other venues (e.g. F&B outlets, gyms): Visitor can enter the venue. Differentiated Safe Management Measures may apply only if an accepted document is shown.

“Allow entry”: Check-in will be recorded.

“Deny entry”: Check-in will not be recorded.
